### OK, here we finally go. Both choices will likely say "+ Add Plan". Hover your mouse cursor above the truncated "Youth Protection Trainin..." to bring up a description box to help differentiate between the "mandatory" and "recommended" training. Click and choose the one marked "mandatory."



Almost there. YPT is in four modules. In order to begin, you must click the course name or the arrow on the right for each section. Once you finish with one, begin with the next. Begin at top and work your way down to the test.

Each section contains unskippable sections. Training takes approx 70-75 minutes if you are paying attention. You can't leave and come back, there are click-prompts to make sure you are chained to your desk. The training may occasionally log you out but it will save the progress you have made. There is a 25 question test at the end.



At the end of this module you should be able to recognize, respond and report the different kinds of abuse experienced by youth. Importantly, you will also know the barriers to abuse and how to utilize them to help create and maintain a safe space for youth.

#### After selecting a module, you must now click the "Open Course" text.



Within each module, you can navigate using these buttons.

- A. Pause the training to answer a phone call, see to crying kids, etc.
